5th & 6th Grade:

Defense will be man to man and NO double teaming. Double teaming means two defensive players trap the player with the ball. Help defense is allowed. Defensive players cannot stand in the lane and play a one-man zone/must be near the player they are guarding.

Play will be 5 on 5. If a team is short players coaches may agree to play 4 on 4 or borrow from a team from the same school.

No full court pressure except in the last minute of the second half and only by the team that is behind by 6 points or less.

Games will be two-20-minute halves with a running clock. The clock will be stopped and started in the last minute of the game if the score is six points or under.

For a non-shooting foul, the team will get the ball back. For an offensive foul, the offended team gets the ball back. In the last two minutes of the game if a team is leading by 6 or less points a bonus free throw will be shot. Clock stops.

Overtime will be 2 minutes long and start with a jump ball. If the score is tied after the first overtime a second overtime will be played with the first team to score declared the winner. A time out is allowed for each team.

Parents are responsible for transportation unless busing is available. Please arrive 10 minutes early to games and pick-up players at designated times.

Most games during the week are played at CMS or St. Joes. Saturday games are at CMS. In case of schedule changes, written notice will be provided. Listen to the radio for all weather-related announcements.
